

## **STRATEGIES FOR HOME-SCHOOL COMMUNICATION**

**Choose five strategies from the list below that you will use to help you to better communicate with families.**

- Use a website to allow parents to see data from classroom continuous improvement.
- Use a website to house effective strategies for parents to support their children's learning at home.
- Send monthly newsletter (electronic or printer) to highlight classroom continuous improvement.
- Send home daily point sheets or logs or notebooks.
- Use electronic school reach for essential communication.
- Beginning of year phone call or letter to introduce self.
- Provide thorough orientation materials at beginning of the year and for parents of new students as they are added.
- Student led IEPs and conferences.
- Send home detailed agendas that outline exactly what we're doing in class & what the homework will be for the next 2-3 weeks.
- Invite parents to class-wide activity.
- Positive phone calls to discuss progress.
- Parent workshops.
- Provide access to parent portal to check on grades, attendances and missing assignments.
- Blind copy email communication with homework/assignments, reminder to check planner.
